OVERVIEW

The Conder, the fifth residential tower at NewQuay and comprising 200 apartments, sits proudly at the head of the NewQuay Promenade in Melbourne's Docklands.

Named after the renowned Australian artist Charles Conder, the Conder forms a point of contrast to the earlier stages in its architectural presentation and style. The curved shape and predominant glass façade of the building has been designed to maximise the views from the apartments to Victoria Harbour, the Bay and the city.

For such a high profile project the architect wanted to specify a very high-quality recessed entrance matting system.

The chosen system needed to support and enhance the entranceway design while protecting internal floors by trapping moisture and grit at the door.

After reviewing the available options, ULTRAMAT from Birrus Matting Systems was selected due to the design flexibility and the hardwearing performance for which it is known in the industry.

The final outcome compliments the entranceway design and will stand up to heavy foot-traffic. Easy to keep clean and maintain, it will retain its visual appeal while doing the essential work of an entranceway matting system.
