When Cecil Rusden founded his company under the name of Rusden Birrell, in August 1948, he could not have imagined that the business story he was starting would span seven decades and three generations of his family.

From their factory in Melbourne, Rusden Birrell quickly became known for bringing the best in design thinking and engineering products to Australia. Cecil was a passionate engineer, innovator and businessman who both imported and manufactured engineering products for the Australian market. The Rusden Birrell factory in Fitzroy became an important local employer helping to develop local engineering skill sets. To this day, the Rusden Birrell sign is still a local landmark on Johnston Street in Fitzroy and a reminder to our staff and customers of our heritage.

A New Direction

In 1965, Cecil sadly died and a new chapter in our history began. After marrying in 1964, Cecil's son, Gregor, emigrated to England. A brilliant engineer in his own right, he had established a career there in truck design and found a new passion in British classic cars including Bentleys and Jaguars. Upon learning of his father's unexpected death, Gregor came home to Australia to take up the reins of the family business.

It was during Gregor's early years at the company that the license was secured to manufacture the Matador range of entry matting in Australia. Gregor had seen this matting in the UK and knew that there was a demand for a high-quality commercial matting system here. The Matador mats were handmade, expensive and only suitable for the prestige buildings of the day. They also had an unfortunate habit of trapping the high-heels of women's shoes. Gregor knew he could come up with better designs and that is what he did.

Birrus Engineering

In the early 70s, under the new name of Birrus Engineering, we became one of the first companies in Australia to start manufacturing matting systems designed here. This was the start of what would become the focus of the business as it became a market leader in matting systems and flooring safety products. Through the 80's and 90's, the business continued to grow in Australia and internationally.

A Single Focus

In 2001, Birrus Engineering ceased trading, the matting division continued under the name Birrus Matting Systems – the company that we are today. This new focus on our most successful product allowed us to cement our position as a specialist manufacturer and leader.

Conceptual Design: Once the needs are understood, a conceptual design is created. This stage often involves sketching and providing samples to contribute to mood boards or other visual aids to help the client visualise the end result.

Material Selection: The materials for the mat are chosen based on the requirements defined in the needs assessment and conceptual design stages. This could involve considerations like durability, ease of cleaning, slip resistance, and aesthetic appeal.

Product Development: A prototype is often created to test the design and materials. This can include 3D printing as a part of the product development process. This stage can reveal potential issues or improvements that weren't apparent in the design phase.

Final Design: After any necessary changes are made based on the prototyping phase, a final design is approved. This design includes detailed specifications that will guide the manufacturing process.

Manufacturing: The production of the mats is a multi-step process, beginning with the development of CAD drawings to capture the required technical measurements. High-quality materials are sourced according to the final design, and electronic measurements ensure precise construction. The manufacturing techniques are applied based on the design specifications. For larger mats that consist of multiple pieces, a detailed production breakdown is followed to facilitate easier manual handling and installation. Each part undergoes a comprehensive labelling process, assigned both numerical and alphabetical identifiers. This meticulous tracking is maintained from the initial stages through to packaging and is verified at each station as part of our ongoing quality checks.

Quality Control: Each product goes through quality checks to ensure it meets the required standards for durability, safety, and appearance. Any products that don't meet these standards are rejected.

Packaging: To ensure the mats are well-protected during transport, we utilise a comprehensive packaging process that includes meticulous labelling and preparation for delivery. In line with our sustainability efforts, we repurpose cardboard and timber to handcraft retrofitted crates, tailored to the size and shape of each mat. This customised approach is especially relevant for all deliveries made outside of metropolitan Melbourne. Each section of the mat is wrapped in plastic, complete with part number labels, and is snugly fitted into these handmade timber crates for secure transport.

Delivery and Installation: The mats are shipped to the client's location and Birrus offers professional installation of the mats in most locations.

Post-Delivery Support: After delivery and installation, the company may provide additional services such as repair with replacement matting inserts when necessary, as well as customer support to address any issues or concerns.


